The study of things that are made by nature. E.g.: plants, volcanoes, seas, rivers,

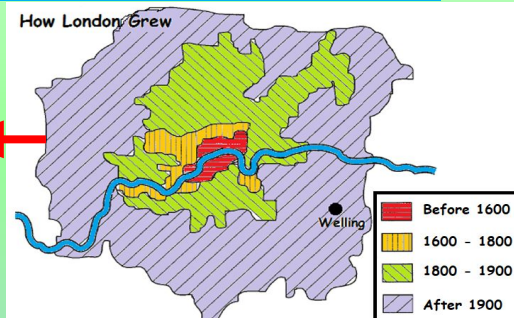
The UK

Physical map of the UK



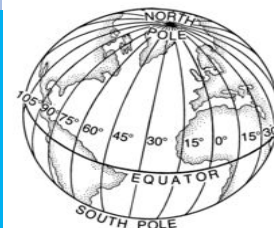
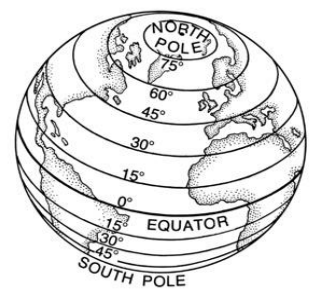
Cities in the UK
